


## 5 - Landscape, Conservation and Recreation

## **Low Activity Scenario**

The aim of the low activity scenario is to provide improved access to the area by walking, cycling and horse riding, with an emphasis on promoting a quiet environment for wildlife and informal recreation.



- New footpaths, cycle ways and bridleways could form a circuit around the reservoir and provide improved links to established networks in the surrounding area.
- A new cycle way could be provided along the route of the pipeline, linking Havant Thicket with the partially complete Emsworth to Christchurch cycle route.
- Nature conservation measures could include the replacement of, and creation of new, woodland and grassland habitat.
- The wetland wildlife area which could attract a wide range of species is located on the northern edge of the reservoir in order to take advantage of the shallow waters, feeder streams and proximity of woodland habitat.
- There is no additional car parking proposed with this scenario.
