



New Water Main work at Havant Thicket

Portsmouth Water is carrying out important work to lay a new water main at Gipsies Plain during August and September 2019.

Following a number of recent bursts on the existing water main that runs below the edge of Gipsies Plain, which caused disruption to water supplies in Rowlands Castle, Portsmouth Water are replacing the main by laying a new 8 inch pipe to help secure water supplies in the area.

The work will take 2 months, starting in the field immediately north of the Staunton Country Park woodland during August. Then in September the new main will be laid down the side of the gravel track known as Cedar Drive. For your safety in September the path will be diverted from Rowlands Castle along the bridleway and south to the track where it joins the woodland, ensuring that local people can still walk from Rowlands Castle into Staunton Country Park and back during the works. The temporary route will be clearly sign posted.
